An important two-tone bronze chandelier, richly decorated with mascarons, in the style of late 19th and early 20th-century French productions inspired by the Louis XIV and Regency styles. This chandelier features an elegant structure in patinated and gilt bronze, offering a refined contrast that highlights the richness of the decoration. The scalloped arms, finely chiseled with scrolls, foliage, and rococo foliage, are adorned with expressive mascarons, giving the whole a sculptural and theatrical presence. The central stem, punctuated by turned and ornamented elements, extends into an elaborate suspension, while the candle holders and sockets are delicately decorated. The piece demonstrates high-quality bronze work, combining decorative power with exquisite execution. It is functionally
