This console table embodies the decorative spirit of the 1940s, in the style of designers Louis Sue and André Mare, emblematic figures of French Art Deco. Its architectural silhouette, understated and refined, combines the rigor of blackened wood with the warmth of courbaril mahogany, in a subtly orchestrated interplay of contrasts. The front is enlivened by a floral marquetry design in stained wood, delicately inlaid with mother-of-pearl, evoking the stylized compositions favored by the workshops of the Union of Modern Artists. The upper drawer, with finely chiseled brass handles, sits above a lower, lockable door, decorated with a floral basket. The fluted uprights rhythmically add elegance to the piece, emphasizing its verticality and reinforcing its graphic appeal. This distinctive piece of
