A charming early 20th-century painting, signed Henri Buron and dated 1939, depicts a bouquet of violets delicately arranged in a deep blue vase.

The artist presents an intimate and poetic composition, where the eye is immediately drawn to the subtle contrast between the deep blue of the vase and the soft, ethereal hues of the violets. The flowers, rendered with light, blended brushstrokes, seem almost to vibrate in a silent, hushed atmosphere, imbued with calm and sensitivity. The supple and nuanced paintwork conveys a great delicacy of execution. Henri Buron perfectly captures the fragility of the bouquet, allowing a discreet, almost melancholic emotion to surface, characteristic of certain still lifes from the interwar period. The deliberately uncluttered, light background highlights the
