An elegant Louis XVI style bouillotte lamp in mahogany and gilt bronze, dating from the 19th century. The lamp has three arms, harmoniously arranged around the central column, with elegant scrolls and foliate candle holders, each holding a faux candle. The whole is surmounted by its original bouillotte lampshade, made of brown lacquered sheet metal, rimmed with brass, and adjustable in height thanks to a central rod ending in a decorative finial. The lamp boasts very fine craftsmanship, balanced proportions, and a warm patina, characteristic of Louis XVI style furniture and lighting.
