We are delighted to offer this exquisite antique Victorian 14ct gold and enamel brooch made c.1870. The brooch features a fabulous target/bullseye design with a striking colour combination of red enamel, white seed pearls, a garnet cabochon and a turquoise accent in the centre. The enamel guilloché has remained in great condition with no chips which is delightful for a piece of this age and the red tones contrasted by the two bands of white pearls certainly leave a striking and lasting impression. Its design and the garnet cabochon in the centre is quintessentially Victorian and distinguishes itself from modern pieces. The garnet presents an alluring and almost mystical look as its tone drastically changes depending on the lighting and angle, from a very dark red to almost matching the enamel. Such

The enamelling has a slight raised curvature, almost 'doughnut-like' - further displaying the intricacy and aesthetic craftsmanship of the period. A thin chain could also be threaded between the pin and brooch to be worn as a pendant, however, we would caution such usage, as without a stopper, it may risk from slipping etc. A very special gift for someone or as an indulgent addition for the discerning antique jewellery lover. This brooch is exemplary of the creative and meticulous Victorian jewellery making and is a wonderful way to display your passion for distinguished antiques, history and style. Garnet is known to be the birthstone for January and pearls for June. The brooch is unmarked, as is common with articles of this period and as such, we have tested it, indicating 14ct gold, with a silver back locket frame. Please note the pin is not gold.
