Description

A series of seven framed engravings illustrating hunting in Asia: *Ceylon, elephant hunt, death of eight elephants and capture of one calf, Logolla *Gall, Tolakodo Hajosok *Ceylon, elephant hunt at Logolla *Ganges Melett, tigress hunt near Murserabat *Java, rhinoceros hunt, Thyszitu, July 7 *Java, crocodile hunt, Batavia, July 26 *Ceylon, elephant hunt, Bibile, May 6. These various views illustrated the work of Count Andrassy, a Hungarian nobleman who fled Budapest in 1849 to travel to the East. His first book, "Voyage to the East Indies," was published in 1853. These engravings all bear the inscriptions Cte Andrasy Delt- Imp Lemercier Paris and V Adam and E Cicéri Lith / H Cleget and Bayot Lith. Beautiful 20th-century frames in gilt lacquered wood with bronze rosettes at the
