Description

A large period portrait from the First Empire, during the reign of Napoleon I, depicting an elegant young woman from high society, either noble or bourgeois, dating from the very beginning of the 19th century. She wears the typical high-waisted dress, cinched under the bust, in keeping with the fashion popularized by Empress Josephine, the Emperor's first wife. This white dress is complemented by an elegantly draped red shawl. The delicately modeled face testifies to the meticulous craftsmanship characteristic of bourgeois portraiture of this era. The hairstyle, rich jewelry, and lace accentuate the subject's refinement and elegance. The overall effect is one of great charm and presence. Some signs of age are visible, consistent with the work's age, attesting to its authenticity. Note that there

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are a few small tears that need repairing; an old restoration is almost invisible on the dress.
