Animal sculpture in regule with a brown patina depicting a hunting dog (a spaniel) holding a pheasant in its mouth. The animal is shown in a pointing position, one leg raised, its body slender and its head turned. The work rests on a rectangular base composed of black marble and light veined marble, characteristic of productions from the second half of the 19th century. Signed Jules Moigniez (1835-1894), famous for his bronze and regule animal sculptures, highly sought after by collectors. On display at the Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, 97 rue de Courcelles, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
