### Description

Pair of Regency period corner cabinets, mid-18th century. Only one of these corner cabinets bears the stamp "CAREL". Jacques-Philippe Carel (1688-1755) was a Parisian cabinetmaker, admitted to the cabinetmakers' guild in 1723. The stamped corner cabinet has a geometric design in mahogany, featuring a lozenge on each door. On each side, the uprights are decorated with two brass moldings, and the rounded lower section is also adorned with a brass molding. It has two doors, a well-organized interior, two shelves, and a mahogany back panel. Dimensions: Height: 81.5 cm, Depth: 56.5 cm. The second corner cabinet also has a geometric design in mahogany.
