Description

This exceptional piece, created around 1950, showcases the shimmering beauty of tiger's eye. The sculpture depicts a delicate bird perched on a gourd (or squash), a traditional motif symbolizing prosperity and lineage continuity. The artisan's work highlights the stone's natural contrasts, alternating between polished areas and finely engraved details on the foliage. The gem's golden, silky reflections lend striking relief to the elongated shape of the fruit. The whole is enhanced by a carved wooden base, typical of mid-20th-century craftsmanship.
