It features a delicately engraved monogram in its center. The lid alone weighs 240 grams, attesting to the high quality of the silversmithing and meticulous craftsmanship. The cut crystal base, with its beautiful, regular facets, offers an elegant play of light and perfectly showcases the silver.
