Patinated bronze group depicting three putti who appear to be in full stride. Bronze with the signature Ch Monginot, "bronze AG Paris" and numbered EL3. Wear to the patina, scratches, small dents/impact marks on the face of one of the putti. Charlotte Monginot (1872-1962) was a French sculptor, daughter of the painter Charles Monginot. She exhibited for the first time at the Salon in 1895 and was named an Officer of the Académie in 1900 (i.e., a member of the Académie Palms, an honorary title for Members of the University of France). In 1903, she won the sculpture prize at the Salon of the Union of Women Painters and Sculptors. In 1910, she received a 3rd class medal.
