The lid, with its finely molded classical decoration, highlighted by a frieze of pearls and stylized decorative elements, is made of sterling silver hallmarked with the Minerva 1st standard hallmark (950/1000). It is adorned in its center with a delicately executed engraved monogram. The lid alone weighs 150 grams, attesting to meticulous craftsmanship and high-quality silversmithing.
