Rare and elegant TIKAL table lamp, designed by Pier Giuseppe Ramella for Arteluce, a major Italian design house of the 20th century. This iconic model embodies the formal and architectural exploration of Italian design in the late 1960s, a period marked by experimentation with materials and a sculptural approach to light. The name TIKAL directly references the famous Mayan site, reflecting the designer's desire to create an object with an almost monumental presence. The lamp consists of a central opal plastic diffuser, the luminous heart of the piece, combined with a large blue-tinted glass screen that structures, filters, and stages the light. When lit, it diffuses a warm and enveloping light, beautifully contrasted by the coolness of the glass, while when unlit, it reads like a true
