Description

Pair of Napoleonic Watercolors - Grande Armée 1812 & Waterloo 1815. Original watercolors on paper depicting two emblematic scenes of the Napoleonic Wars, created by Georges Toumasov, a 20th-century artist active in Moscow, specializing in illustration and historical military reenactment. These works demonstrate precise and well-documented work, both in the rendering of the uniforms and in the representation of the horses and military contexts. Works comprising the pair: - The Grande Armée in 1812 - Light Horse Trumpeter. Watercolor signed lower right and dated 1971. - English Dragoons in front of the mill at Mont-Saint-Jean, before the Battle of Waterloo (1815). Watercolor signed and dated 1970. 23.5 x 17.7 cm. Trace of dampness on the one (light horse trumpeter).
