From the piece: Koko ga Edo Ko-ude no Tatehiki, 1863. Beautiful triptych, some wear to the edges, light dusting. Oban Nishiki-e. Each approximately: 240 x 360 cm. Ukiyo-e artist, also known as Ikkeisai, Keisai, Asakero, and Betsugo. A student of Kuniyoshi, he began producing color prints in the early Ansei period (1854-1859), specializing in portraits of actors and women. During the Meiji period, he became a renowned newspaper illustrator, working for several newspapers.
