Here is a rare side table or display table on the market. It is a piece of Art Deco style furniture from around 1920. This table was made in Belgium. According to the sellers' family legend, it is a unique, custom-made piece commissioned around 1920 from "De Coene Frères" in Kortrijk, which had a department within its company dedicated to high-end, personalized orders. I have no documents to confirm the veracity of this story, but it remains true that this piece of furniture is exceptional in many respects. First, its very personal and luxurious design. Second, the meticulous care taken in its creation and the choice of materials used. These are all top-of-the-range, namely mahogany, mahogany burl and burr, rosewood, and solid black lacquered oak.
