Drop earrings in 18k yellow gold (750/°°, owl hallmark) are primarily and simply adorned with rows of spinels, whose subtle color, depending on the light, can be pink, violet, orange, or brown. The pink and violet tones are highlighted in natural daylight, while warmer artificial light reveals the pinkish-orange hues more fully. Spinel is rarely found set in jewelry, and this more exclusive and lesser-known stone offers incomparable brilliance. These highly vibrant stones are arranged in a graduated, increasingly teardrop shape. The effect is amplified by the bezel settings that encase each stone. These two-part earrings consist of a fixed stud for pierced ears with post backs, and an articulated band attached to this base. The band's movement allows it to catch more light and gives the

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earrings a lovely sway when worn. Estimated total spinel weight: approximately 2.60 carats. Gross weight: 3.80 g. Condition: Imperceptible micro-scratches on the gold; characteristic natural inclusions in the spinels are not visible when worn. Payment can be made entirely online via the website.
