Omega steel watch from the 1950s. Omega, a pioneer in the field, offered a watch with a particularly large diameter for its time. Its clean, minimalist case reflects the design of watches in the following decade. The luminous dial boasts a magnificent color and patina, highlighting the bronze-colored hands, hour markers, and logo. The crown is also signed. The equally minimalist case back is smooth to the touch, with a domed shape reminiscent of bubble backs. It is equipped with a mechanical, hand-wound movement. Although its leather strap has since been replaced, the watch retains its original pin buckle. The watch is signed on both the dial and the movement. In perfect condition and serviced, its proper functioning is guaranteed by us for one year (except in case of shock or immersion). A
