Description

Art Nouveau Vase - Edmond Lachenal (1855-1930) Polychrome glazed ceramic. A rare and remarkable Art Nouveau vase signed by Edmond Lachenal, a major figure in French ceramics of the late 19th and early 20th centuries. This vase is distinguished by its slender, organic form, evoking a bud or a stylized corolla, typical of the naturalistic aesthetic so dear to Art Nouveau. The surface is enlivened by a richly textured polychrome glaze: deep and nuanced greens, luminous yellows, and ruby reds unfold in broad vegetal motifs highlighted by slightly raised veins. The vibrant and almost lifelike material reveals Lachenal's mastery of flamed and nuanced glazes, making each piece a unique work of art. The variations in color, the controlled drips, and the depth of the tones give this vase a
