The six semicircular sides are decorated in relief with dragons, phoenixes, and a kilin. The openwork lid finial features a figure running through mist, carrying a lit lantern. Greek key friezes run across the entire piece, creating a highly delicate ensemble that reflects the taste and refinement of the wealthy classes of 19th-century China. The object is in very good condition. # The phoenix, sometimes spelled phoenix or phoenix, is a mythical bird endowed with immense longevity. It is characterized by its power to be reborn either from its own corpse or from the flames of its funeral pyre. # The kilin (or qilin) is a fantastic animal from the bestiary.
