Ebonized wood altar crucifix, adorned with a silver Corpus Christi (silver tested, not hallmarked), mounted on a stepped architectural base, incorporating three circular reliquary cases under glass. Description: The cross is highlighted by a decorative silver-plated metal frame and features, beneath Christ's feet, a skull and crossbones motif (Adam), in accordance with traditional iconography. The hexagonal base is enriched with decorative cartouches and three reliquaries sealed with red wax, each containing several authentic relics identified by their authentic Latin handwritten inscriptions.
