A bronze sculpture with a brown patina by the French sculptor Félix Maurice Charpentier (1858-1924), depicting "The Improviser." The figure evokes a young man playing an improvised flute made from a branch, captured in a moment of spontaneity and natural grace. The work displays meticulous modeling, with particular attention paid to anatomy and the balance of the posture, characteristic of late 19th-century French academic sculpture. The warm patina highlights the quality of the casting and the lyrical sensibility of the artist. The bronze is signed "Félix Charpentier" and dated 1887, and bears the stamp of the prestigious Société des Bronzes de Paris, attesting to a high-quality Parisian casting.
