Description

This Antique Paintings category depicts a rough sea, with breaking waves crashing onto the shoreline, rendered through a dynamic and textured brushwork. The color palette features natural tones, with shades of blue, green, and grey, balanced by subtle luminous reflections that effectively convey the ever-changing atmosphere of sea and sky.

In the background, the silhouette of a sailing boat emerges, adding depth and a strong sense of distance to the composition.

The artwork is housed in a fine lacquered wooden frame, original and contemporary to the painting, known as a Montparnasse frame.

Both the painting and the frame have undergone careful, professional restoration.
