Louis XV Cherrywood Commode - 18th Century.
This Louis XV commode, crafted from solid cherrywood, dates from the 18th century. It features two small drawers in the upper section and two large drawers in the front, all fitted with handles and chiseled bronze keyhole escutcheons. The front and sides are shaped, typical of the Louis XV style, and adorned with a geometric marquetry design framing each drawer. The uprights rest on cabriole legs. In good overall condition. Some older restorations consistent with age. No key. Viewable at Galerie Courcelles Antiquités, 41 rue des Acacias, in the 17th arrondissement of Paris.
