Description

An elegant pair of four-light candelabra in finely chased and patinated bronze, enhanced with gilt bronze elements. Each candelabra consists of a slender, column-shaped central shaft, adorned with rings and capitals richly decorated with foliage and classical motifs. The elegantly sinuous arms support finely crafted candle cups, balanced around a central socket. The whole rests on an architecturally designed base with openwork decoration, supported by a quadrangular plinth embellished with broad scrolls, acanthus leaves, and gilt bronze ornaments, typical of the Neoclassical style of the Restoration period. The chasing is of exceptional quality, and there is a harmonious contrast between the dark patina of the bronze and the brilliance of the gilt. A striking decorative piece,
