A patinated bronze candlestick, resting on a circular base, features a twisted stem entwined by a serpent, a symbolic and decorative motif highly prized in the 19th century. The stem is surmounted by a circular socket and a molded drip tray, the whole presenting an elegant and balanced silhouette. The finely modeled serpent decoration testifies to the quality of casting and chasing characteristic of the productions of the Ferdinand Barbedienne firm, one of the greatest French art founders of the 19th century. The base is signed "F. BARBEDIENNE," a renowned signature guaranteeing meticulous execution and great fidelity to the original designs.
