

### Description

A major figure of French geometric abstraction, James Guitet developed a rigorous visual language influenced by Op Art and research into visual perception. His work is founded on the disciplined arrangement of forms and contrasts, generating a dynamic interplay between movement, balance and optical tension.

This original etching from 1959 stands at the heart of Guitet's graphic exploration. The carefully structured composition, built through precise lines and controlled contrasts, creates an impression of rhythm and depth. The visual vibration produced by the interaction of geometric elements is characteristic of Guitet's refined and methodical approach.
