### Description

Cesare Borgia (1475-1507) Son of Pope Alexander VI, Cesare Borgia is one of the most fascinating and controversial figures of the Italian Renaissance. Made a cardinal at a very young age, he abandoned his ecclesiastical career to become a military leader and statesman. His political actions, marked by a desire for domination and great tactical skill, deeply impressed his contemporaries. Niccolò Machiavelli saw him as the model of the ideal Prince, capable of imposing order through intelligence and force. César Borgia's face immediately draws attention with his intense gaze. The simplicity of the pose contrasts with the refinement of the
