Description

Oil on canvas depicting a female nude, attributed to Fernand Maxence de Chambord (1840-1889), a French painter active during the second half of the 19th century. The figure is shown half-length, in an elegant and gently inclined pose, treated with notable softness and sensitivity. The careful modelling of the flesh, the subtle transitions of tone, and the mastery of half-tones reflect a solid academic training and an intimate approach to the subject. This work is fully rooted in the tradition of late 19th-century French academic painting, a period in which the female nude became a privileged field of study, combining rigorous drawing with a refined search for expressive nuance.
