Description

A beautiful and elegant pair of altar candlesticks in patinated, carved natural wood. The feet feature a complex design with three projecting sections and a body adorned with gadrooned motifs. The column base is decorated with palmette friezes, and the top terminates in a generously flared candle holder embellished with carvings and ornaments that decorate the upper part of the tapered base. A lovely decorative piece, it also features screw-in sockets on top for electrification, allowing for the creation of attractive tall lamps. Dating from the reign of Louis XIV, these two Baroque-style church ornaments possess all the qualities of a carefully chosen, high-quality decoration in the "Haute Époque" style. Long preserved from pests, these two large candlesticks, with their restrained
