Presented in their elegant gilt and stuccoed wood frames with palmettes and a black border framed with neo-Gothic lacework, and under the gilt titles "Mary Stuart Leaving France & Henry of England Coming to France," two historical subjects carefully staged in a tragic spirit, full of tears and emotion. The remarkably magnificent scenes of these two moments in history are very much in keeping with the spirit of the Restoration, during the return of the Ancien Régime under the patronage of Charles X. Perfectly preserved and playing with light with refinement, these beautiful scenes with two figures are in excellent condition and reflect the taste of the period, that of an exacerbated
