Description

This type of work is particularly valued for its decorative appeal and its nostalgic evocation of European hunting traditions. The ornate gilt frame, typical of the period, adds to the aesthetic and historical value of this piece. The painting has been cleaned by our art conservator and is in excellent condition.
