Pastel depicting a harbor scene at sunset, with moored fishing boats and reflections on the water. Georges Libotte's work here is characterized by a soft and luminous atmosphere, a subtle palette of warm and cool tones, and a delicate handling of the medium typical of pastels and oil pastels. The balanced and poetic composition evokes the calm of a harbor at the end of the day. The work is signed lower left and dated 1992, attesting to the artist's mature production at the end of the 20th century. It is presented framed, with a mat and under glass, ready to hang.
