A silver-plated flatware set from Christofle in Paris, the SPATOURS pattern, which appeared in the first Christofle catalog in 1862. This iconic pattern is still available today. It draws inspiration from the aesthetics of 18th-century objects. Its name is a contraction of the words "spatula" and "contour," describing the decoration with its sinuous line that accentuates the curve of the cutlery. This set comprises: 18 dinner spoons, 18 dinner forks, 12 dinner knives, 12 dessert spoons, 12 dessert forks, 12 cheese knives, 12 cheese forks, 12 fish forks, 12 fish knives, 12 oyster forks, 8 teaspoons, 6 serving pieces, and 1 sugar tong.
