Creation of Daum glass productions for the Verrerie d'Art Lorrain (VAL) during the Art Deco period (1910-1939), this multilayer marble-effect glass vase is emblematic of the productions of this period, where luxurious & refined geometry are master of design. During the years 1925 to 1934, the Verrerie d'Art Lorrain also known as Verrerie de la Belle Étoile in Croismare was created by Daum & Cie but distinct from the factory in Nancy. This production is distinguished by vases with a nuanced appearance in colors (here mauve and blue) with a marmorean effect. Rare and sought after, the vases of these productions are worthy of the luxury of the Art Deco period. Its large size
