Louis XV period buffet in solid carved wood, 18th century. Provincial work. Important low buffet in solid wood, of fine antique workmanship, featuring a front richly decorated with carved decoration typical of the provincial Louis XV style. It opens with two drawers in the frieze, adorned with decorative metal fittings, above two molded doors with scalloped lines and rocaille motifs. The cut-iron keyhole escutcheons and handles emphasize the authentic, antique character of the piece. The central rail is adorned with carved motifs, while the lower plinth features a stylized shell motif, flanked by foliage and resting on cabriole legs, lending elegance and movement to the whole. The wood, likely walnut or fruitwood, displays a warm, antique patina, with nuances and traces of time that enhance the
