It has a rounded base, engraved sides, and a top rim with two lugs that allow a wrought iron handle to swing freely within them. Side is decorated of small lys flowers punched, framing a superb, swirling garland embossed with a small hammer, in a Gothic style. 26cm x 23cm. Weight 1.1kg.
