Description

Orientalist School, late 19th century. Horsemen in a desert landscape. Oil on panel depicting a lively Orientalist scene featuring three horsemen progressing through an arid and rocky landscape. The central figure, mounted on a white horse, is emphasized by his red garment and dominant position, while two riders follow him in the background. The dynamic composition, the meticulous rendering of the horses, and the luminous atmosphere convey a mastery of movement and pictorial narrative. The palette, dominated by warm tones--ochres, browns, and reds--is balanced by a clear sky with bluish hues.
