Roche Bobois Coffee Table, 1970s. Roche Bobois is a French company founded in the 1960s through the merger of the Roche and Chouchan ("Bobois") families. It quickly established itself as a producer of contemporary furniture, created in collaboration with designers. The 1970s marked a turning point: modernist aesthetics, modular forms, the use of glass, chrome, and lacquer, and iconic designs (e.g., Hans Hopfer's Mah Jong collection, 1971). The brand developed an international network, meticulously curated catalogs, and high-quality craftsmanship. A Roche Bobois coffee table from the 1970s embodies this aesthetic: graphic design, fine materials, and the glamorous spirit of the era--a sought-after vintage classic to complement a contemporary or mid-century living room.
