Description

Pair of wrought iron candlesticks by Charles Piguet, circa 1940. A silversmith active in Geneva during the 20th century (c. 1900-1950), Charles Piguet created tableware and decorative pieces in silver or silver-plated metal: candlesticks, candelabras, bowls, and dinner services. His style ranges from classical/neoclassical to a restrained Art Deco, with meticulous proportions. A maker's mark "CP" (variant depending on the period) is found alongside the Swiss hallmarks: "grouse" before 1934, and a Saint Bernard's head after 1934.
