Description

Important carved and giltwood mirror, of Lombard origin, dating to the mid-18th century, and representative of the mature Rococo style of Northern Italy. The frame is richly carved with scrolls, foliage and vegetal motifs, dynamically developed along the entire outline and surmounted by an elegant pierced cresting. The deep and lively carving reflects a high level of craftsmanship, intended for a refined interior. The original mercury glass is preserved, showing the natural ageing, oxidation and soft patina typical of the period, confirming its authenticity. The original backboard has been retained, a noteworthy and desirable feature. The gilt finish, executed in gold leaf, is in good condition, with minor later retouching in bronze powder, small localized restorations and some old structural
