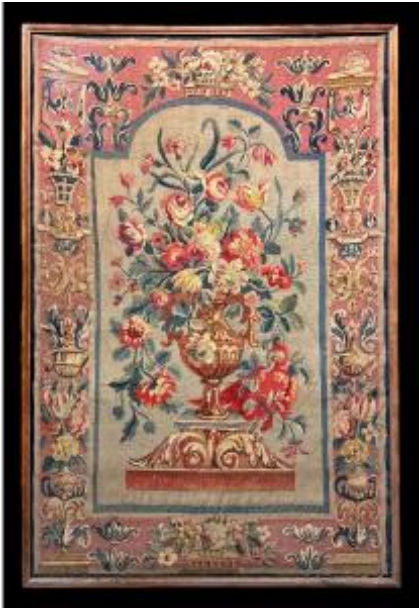




## Large Aubusson Tapestry Bouquet Of Flowers - Late 18th Century

### Description

This sumptuous French tapestry from the mid-18th century is a true celebration of the communion of the arts, where the fineness of the weaving serves a pictorial composition of extraordinary lyrical ambition. Framed within a Rococo architectural structure, the work celebrates beauty through a central bouquet of exuberantly overflowing flowers, where roses, tulips, and carnations seem to spring from the freshness of an eternal spring. The work is a celebration of the exoticism inherent in the spirit of the flamboyant Rococo; the presence of a parrot with brilliant plumage, perched at the foot of the chased bronze vase, introduces this curiosity for the distant and the precious that so fascinated European courts. golden ochres, creates an atmosphere of lightness and elegance that testifies to the expertise of French manufacturers during the reign of Louis XV. It is essential to emphasize the exceptional state of preservation of this piece. It is remarkable how well the dyes have retained their brilliance and the fabric its structure, allowing us to admire every detail of the borders and decorative panels with the same clarity as over two centuries ago.
