Description

Two oval silver reliquaries, dating to the 19th century, originally intended for private devotion and now offered exclusively as objects of historical, artistic and collectible interest. The mounts feature a finely executed openwork and chased decoration, with late Baroque-inspired ornamental motifs, and retain their original suspension rings. Inside are preserved relics mounted according to traditional practice, with textile supports and gilt metal thread decoration. The handwritten labels are not fully legible, making it impossible to identify the saint with certainty, a common occurrence in objects of this kind. Larger reliquary: height 7 cm, width 3.8 cm. Smaller reliquary: height 6 cm, width 3.5 cm. Overall good condition, with age-related wear consistent with period and use; mounts are
