Description

Signed and numbered under the base: "Pottery - Pol Chambost - 2084 - Made in France - H" This rare piece perfectly illustrates the formal modernity and sculptural elegance characteristic of Pol Chambost's work. Conceived as a double volume connected by an architecturally structured central handle, the object subtly oscillates between utilitarian function and abstract sculpture. The organic silhouette, with its supple and balanced curves, is enhanced by a deep matte black glaze, an emblematic signature of the ceramist in the post-war years. Chambost, initially trained as a sculptor, developed in his creations a constant search for harmony between pure lines, sensual volumes, and formal innovation, making him one of the major French ceramists of the 20th century.
