Important Art Deco marbled glass bowl signed Schneider, France, circa 1925-1935. This large, footed bowl is crafted from artistic glass by Schneider, a leading name in French Art Deco glassmaking. The bowl is made of thick marbled glass, displaying a remarkable interplay of colors: luminous amber, warm orange, and golden brown, enhanced by a rim highlighted in a particularly elegant deep cobalt blue. The gradations are finely blended, offering a rich interplay of colors depending on the light and viewing angle, demonstrating exceptionally high-level glasswork. The wide, flared shape rests on a baluster-shaped foot of dark, purplish glass, creating a refined contrast characteristic of Schneider's work from the 1920s. The piece exudes a strong decorative presence, typical of
