Elegant pair of small frames in finely carved wood with mecca gilding, attributable to Italian production from the mid-19th century. Based on their typology and structure, they were likely originally cantaglorie (liturgical decorative elements), later converted into frames. The frames feature rich scroll and foliate decoration both on the upper crest and the lower section, with shaped feet allowing them to stand. The mecca gilding, now pleasantly time-worn, shows natural wear and craquelure that enhance their authenticity and antique charm. Ideal pieces for collectors or for classic and eclectic interiors, perfect for displaying small prints, miniatures, or devotional images.
