Description

Description
Important carved and gilt wooden base dating to the 17th century, likely once part of a small domestic altar or devotional ensemble. The front is embellished with an elegant winged cherub finely carved among scrolls and ornamental motifs typical of the Baroque taste. The gilding, largely original, shows a pleasing aged patina with natural wear that confirms its authenticity and long use. The upper section is shaped in a half-moon form, designed

Condition Report
Solid structure. Wear, abrasions, and small losses to the gilding consistent with age. Traces of old workmanship and an even patina. No evident invasive restorations; any minor consolidations do not affect the overall readability of the piece.

Notes
Authentic Baroque artifact, noteworthy for the quality of the carving and the frontal cherub motif. Ideal as a display base for wooden or terracotta sculptures, or as a standalone decorative object.
