Description

A terracotta bust of Uriela, stamped as made in Cologne, has a title to be determined. This bust bears the Uriela stamp and below it "modeled Cologne". According to the Dawson City Museum, these statues were sold in the Egyptian pavilion, aptly named "A Street in Cairo", at the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago. The World's Columbian Exposition, also known as the World's Columbian Exposition, was the largest of its time. Orientalist and Africanist sculptures were very popular with the bourgeoisie during the Napoleon III era, at the end of the 19th century. In the style of Austrian "Goldscheider" terracotta sculptures. ORIGIN: Cologne, Germany. CIRCA: late 19th century. Some wear to the patina, no missing pieces. Dimensions: Height 44 cm, Width 26 cm, and Depth 20 cm.
