An Ersari rug is a handmade tribal rug, traditionally woven by the Ersari people of the Turkmen of Central Asia (Turkmenistan, Afghanistan, Uzbekistan). It is characterized by deep reds, terracotta hues, and earthy tones, achieved through naturally dyed wool. Its hand-knotted construction with hand-spun wool gives it both durability and softness. Highly versatile, it ranges from antique tribal rugs to modern interpretations.
